PRAYER CIRCLES are a powerful spiritual gift of prayer from your fellow parishioners **encircling** you with God's loving comfort when you need it most.

Upon receiving a prayer request, text messages are sent to a group of about 30 "prayer warriors" who immediately stop what they are doing and offer a prayer on your behalf. Within minutes a growing chorus of prayer ascends to the throne of God for your prayer concerns or thanksgiving.

To initiate a prayer request: call the office, submit through our website or call or text the ministry leader.

Requests remain confidential and discreet- no last name or details are used. Names remain with our Prayer Circles, Weekly Prayer Lists and Sunday Prayers of the People for one month unless otherwise requested.
